Fundraising Ideas

FirstGiving - Personalize your web page with a picture and share why you're raising money. Then send emails to friends and family.

Facebook - Reach out to your Facebook friends. Invite them to join your team or ask them to pledge you.

Your Birthday - Instead of gifts, ask friends and family to donate to your fundraising. Have a puzzle party and let everyone know how you're working to raise autism awareness!
